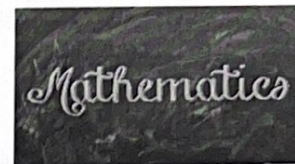

<u>How to Earn Math Money</u>	<u>How to Lose Math Money-50¢</u>
A on a chapter test (\$1)	Dropping a school calculator
B on a chapter test (50¢)	Not coming prepared
Class participation (25¢-\$1)	Turning in assignments without your #
Returning start of year items (\$1-\$3)	Needing an extra copy of notes or worksheet
Review game prizes (25¢-\$1)	0 on completion homework
Student of the month (\$1)	Tardy
Completing a row on your "dot" card (\$1)	Inappropriate behavior - may warrant multiple fines or be given detention/office referral

**Rewards/Consequences:**

- ✦ Students can earn math money to purchase extra credit or raffle tickets
- ✦ Students will begin with some math money at the beginning of each quarter (amounts will vary)
- ✦ Math money will be earned or lost based on classroom participation and behavior

**Rewards/Consequences:**

- ✦ Students with a negative balance at the end of each quarter will be issued detentions

<u>Math money balance</u>	<u># of detentions</u>
-25¢ to -\$1.00	1
-\$1.25 to -\$2.00	2
-\$2.25 or more	up to the discretion of the teacher

## **How you will be graded**

- ❖ Homework - Completion
  - 4 points - ALL problems are completed in pencil - with the required work shown
  - 2 points - at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the problems are completed - you will earn this, even if only 1 problem is not attempted
  - 0 points - less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the problems are completed, no work is shown, or work is not done in pencil
- ❖ Homework - Graded
  - Percents will be calculated and converted to a grade of 0-10 points
  - 90%-100% = 10    80%-89% = 9    70%-79% = 8    60%-69% = 7    50%-59% = 6
  - 40-49% = 5    30%-39% = 4    20%-29% = 3    10%-19% = 2    1%-9% = 1
- ❖ I-Ready assignments - Graded/Completion
  - I will go over this more later
- ❖ Assessments
  - concept check, project, quiz, or test - points will vary
- ❖ Note and binder checks - points will vary

- ❖ Late work without an excused absence will not be accepted if you are absent...
